1) Restrain large animals	Working with possible chemically contaminated animals Bites/scrapes/gorges Stepping on/falling on Allergic reactions Animal borne pathogens	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • See JHA #7, Working with Large Animals
2) Prepare Large Animal for transport	Working with possible chemically contaminated animals Bites/scrapes/gorges Stepping on/falling on Allergic reactions Animal borne pathogens	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Assure the animal is properly restrained • Inspect the animal trailer/vehicle to assure it is safe for the animal and handlers • Ready the animal • Have an experienced animal handler lead the animal into the trailer/vehicle
3) Transport the animal	Motor vehicle Trailer	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • See JHA # 3, driving or automobiles • Care must be taken as vehicle is carrying a heavy load and will react differently than when unloaded
