

Tables Section

Tables allow you to place limits on your data without affecting the results section.

When you place limits in the Results section

- You have to keep track of the limits on the data. It becomes very easy to limit yourself out of data by forgetting what types of limits were placed in the Results Section.
- The limit affects all the other sections, Reports, Tables and Pivots created from the results section.

Tables allow you to get around these problems:

- Tables allow you to change the name to reflect the limits in the data.
- You can create Reports and Pivots based on the data on the limits.
- The limits on tables only affect the table and any Reports or Pivots created on top of the Table, but doesn't change the original Report or Pivots based off the Results section.
- You can create as many tables as necessary on the data from the Results section without re-running data or going back into the Results section each time you are interested in different information.
