

Unprocessed Wool or other Hair Intended for Dispatch to the European Community

The European Union has not published a harmonized import certificate for the import of the above products. Therefore, individual countries may require variations in the below certificate. **Exporters should be especially diligent to have their importers confirm prior to export with the Ministry of Agriculture of the importing country that the issued certificate meets all entry requirements.**

The below certificate is a mock up derived from the requirements explained in Regulation (EC) 1774/2002 and Regulation (EC) 829/2007. It is not a harmonized EU certificate, and may not necessarily be accepted by all EU member countries.

Special note for materials that are not dried:

The competent authority of the importing country may allow derogation from the requirement that materials be dry prior to shipping. Exporters should have their importers contact the pertinent Ministry of Animal Health in the importing country for more information.

II. Health attestation

I, the undersigned official veterinarian, declare that I have read and understood Regulation (EC) No 1774/2002⁽¹⁾ and certify that:

II.1 the animal-byproducts referred to in this certificate:

(a) have been prepared exclusively with animal-byproducts originating from:

(²) either - animals that are slaughtered in a slaughterhouse, after undergoing ante-mortem inspection, and were fit, as a result of such inspection, for slaughter for human consumption in accordance with community legislation;

(²) and/or - animals that did not show clinical signs of any disease communicable through that product to humans or animals;

(b) and are dry and securely enclosed in packaging.

Notes

Part I:

- Box reference I.6: Person responsible for the consignment in EU: this box is to be filled in only if it is a certificate for transit commodity; it may be filled in if the certificate is for import commodity.
- Box reference I.12: Place of destination: this box is to be filled in only if it is a certificate for transit commodity. The products in transit can only be stored in free zones, free warehouses and custom warehouses.
- Box reference I.15: Registration number (railway wagons or container and lorries), flight number (aircraft) or name (ship) and information is to be provided in the event of unloading and reloading.
- Box reference I.19: use the appropriate HS code.
- Box reference I.23: for bulk containers, the container number and the seal number (if applicable) should be given.
- Box reference I.26 and I.27: fill in according to whether it is a transit or an import certificate.
