

Dairy Products for Human Consumption

Export certificates for dairy products for human consumption must state that the country of origin is free of foot and mouth disease (FMD), rinderpest, contagious bovine pleuropneumonia and African swine fever.

The VS Form 16-4 already contains certification regarding foot-and-mouth disease, rinderpest, and contagious bovine pleuropneumonia.

Into the “ADDITIONAL DECLARATION,” the statement “African swine fever does not exist in the United States” should be added.

In the “PRODUCT” box, the product name, number of packages, description of packages, and weight of the products must be included.

Shelf-stable and highly-processed products may not require certification- exporters should have their importers confirm with Taiwanese authorities prior to shipment.
