

Appendix 5.2.2 - Disinfection of Fish Farms

General comment: The concentrations and methods of use for iodine referenced in Article 5.2.2.2, Table 1, should be changed (**bold wording**) to reflect the iodine concentrations and methods as suggested in Article 5.2.1.2, Conditions of use.

Article 5.2.2.2

Table 1, Disinfection and method of use

Current language

Iodine (iodophors) - Eyed eggs - 100 mg iodine/litre for not more than 30 minutes.

Suggested language

Iodine (iodophors) – Eyed eggs - 100 mg iodine/litre **(active ingredient), for a period of not less than 10 minutes. Disinfection solution should be used only once.**

Current language

Iodine (iodophors) - Gametes during fertilization- 25 mg iodine for several hours.

Suggested language

Iodine (iodophors) – Gametes during fertilization - **Not less than 50 mg iodine/litre for a period not less than 30 minutes**
